## REGISTRATION/PHOTOS

Registration is free for all children post-kindergarten living in Perry County who complete the enclosed registration and income survey. We would like to receive registrations during our Pre-Registration events. You may also register at the beginning of your first YouthShop, but may be turned away if workshops are full. You may also mail in your signed registration. Please be aware that due to our funding source, **it is required that parents fill out an income survey**. These surveys will be kept confidential. Youth of all income levels are welcome to attend at no cost.

Some photos will be taken during the summer for newspaper stories and publicity. You will be asked for permission on the registration form as to whether your child's photo may be used.

## SUMMER LUNCHES

Lunch is served at no cost each weekday from 12:30-1:30 at the Shelter House at the Shawnee Ballpark (Nicofibers) and 1-2PM at the Holland Center in Corning. It is also served in downtown New Straitsville.

## SPECIAL NEEDS/MEDICAL ISSUES

It is important that you **let us of know of any medical or dietary needs or physical conditions that your child experiences** that will require special accommodations. Please do so in advance!

## DROP-OFF/PICK UP/TRANSPORTATION

The place and time that your child should show up and be picked up is listed with each YouthShop. Some of the YouthShops will involve hikes and short trips in vans near the towns. Parents will be notified in advance of any field trips that leave the area. For the first time this year we will have Perry County Transit service available for children in New Straitsville for pick up and return in front of the Monday Creek Watershed/SPICE offices for workshops in Shawnee. They will also provide pre-arranged transport services. Just ask us about the details.

## AGES & AGE GROUPING

Children must be ready to enter first grade to attend. Wherever possible we will divide groups into "youngers" and "olders" to assure age-appropriate experiences. Experience tells us that some young teens might be reluctant to register. Most workshops are set up for age 6-14, but some are open to teens up to 18--if you are older and interested, just ask. Teens can be of great help in doing the more complicated tasks and helping adults!

## WATER BOTTLES

We ask that **children bring their own water bottle** with their name on it. We will have water available to fill the bottles. This is important for health purposes and teaching children not to waste.
